On 28 September 2023, Prime Minister the Honourable Mark Brown participated in a Summit to discuss the future of critical minerals, joining other Ministers, industry leaders, heads of international organisations and civil society from around the world. The first-of-its-kind Summit was convened by the International Energy Agency (IEA) at its headquarters in Paris, France.
