Where is Energas located in the Dominican Republic?

Energas is a major electricity generator in the Dominican Republic through the 300 MW San Pedro de Macor's Electricity Company (CESPM) power plant,located in the Eastern regionof the country.

Does the Dominican Republic need a natural gas infrastructure solution?

However, the Eastern region of the country where Energas' facility is located lacked existing natural gas networks or pipelines to transport natural gas. The Dominican Republic needed a holistic infrastructure solution to strategically shift from conventional generation to natural gas.

How is electricity distributed in the Dominican Republic?

Electricity is then publicly distributed through either Edenorte,Edesur,or Edeeste. OC (Organismo Coordinador) is responsible for the coordination of the dispatch of electricity across the Dominican Republic via the national interconnected electrical system.
