The new constitution also creates the position of vice president, appointed by the president, and restricts the ability to run for the presidency to individuals with "Central African origins," excluding Central Africans holding dual nationality. This new stipulation transforms candidate origins into a cornerstone of political legitimacy.

In August 2023, the Central African government signed a decree granting prima facie refugee status to Sudanese fleeing the conflict. Since the beginning of the Sudan crisis in April 2023, the Central African Republic has received 28, 871 refugees as of 11 August 2024.
