

How many MW is a solar power plant in the Ivory Coast?

The authorities in the Ivory Coast have completed a 37.5 MW solar plant, with a second development phase now underway to increase its capacity to 80 MW. The first phase of a solar power plant in the northern part of the Ivory Coast has been inaugurated.

How much solar power does Ivory Coast have in 2023?

Ivorian Energy Minister Mamadou Sangafowa Coulibaly has also revealed plans to expand the capacity of the Boundiali plant to 80 MW. Why is Ivory Coast launching a solar power plant?

Ivory Coast's first solar power plant represents a significant step towards a greener and more resilient energy future. By reconciling economic development and environmental protection, the country is showing the way to a successful energy transition.

Who financed the Ivory Coast solar power station?

The 75.6-million-euro (\$82.1-million) cost of building the solar power station was financed by Ivory Coast, a German loan and a European Union grant. "This is the result of the EU's long-standing commitment to the renewable energy sector, with almost 140 million euros since 2017," EU ambassador to Ivory Coast Francesca Di Mauro told AFP.

Does Ivory Coast need fossil fuels?

By 2030, Ivory Coast has pledged to increase its share of renewable energy to 45 percent, including nine percent solar, and to reduce its greenhouse gas emissions by 30 percent. Fossil fuels however still play a key role. The West African nation recently discovered two huge oil and natural gas deposits.

"After having experimented fossil fuels and hydroelectricity, Ivory Coast, which is rich in renewable energy potential, is about to commission its first solar power plant, marking its intention to vary its energy mix as much as possible," stated Sidibé during the plant's inauguration ceremony, adding, "Resolved to position itself as ...

Solar capacity in Ivory Coast far behind neighbouring countries. But despite the change in political thinking and the more favourable economic conditions, there are still hardly any solar plants in Côte d'Ivoire.
