Today in Lebanon, mafia like gangs have a monopoly on private generators, the fuel to run them and the power lines to connect to them -- making Lebanese and refugee families dependent on these gangs for any reliable electricity supply. On top of this the current economic collapse in Lebanon has made energy matters worse for families.

The number of household solar photovoltaic systems installed in Lebanon has expanded exponentially since the onset of the crisis.
