In November, the Faroe Islands settle into a cooler, windier rhythm. Temperatures range between 3°C and 8°C (37°F to 46°F). More frequent scattered showers or misty drizzle often roll in from the sea, giving the islands a dramatic, mist-covered look.

The Faroe Islands have been part of the Kingdom of Denmark since 1380 and self-governing since 1948. Denmark does subsidize a part of the gross domestic product of the Faroes these days, and they also look after certain sectors like justice, defense, and foreign affairs. The worst time to visit the Faroe Islands is the winter. The weather and daylight are the worst for exploring the archipelago. Winter in the Faroe Islands is a cold, windy time of the year. Keep in mind that the Faroe Islands are very far north, so it makes sense that the winters here are fairly intense.

April Weather in Faroe Islands Faroe Islands. Daily high temperatures increase by 3°F, from 42°F to 45°F, rarely falling below 36°F or exceeding 50°F.. Daily low temperatures increase by 3°F, from 36°F to 38°F, rarely falling below 29°F or exceeding 43°F.. For reference, on August 3, the hottest day of the year, temperatures in Faroe Islands typically range from 48°F to 54°F, while ...
