Which is bigger Svalbard or Jan Mayen?

Svalbard is an archipelago located in the Arctic Ocean, situated about halfway between mainland Norway and the North Pole. The largest island in the Svalbard archipelago is Spitsbergen. Jan Mayen, on the other hand, is a separate volcanic island located in the Arctic Ocean, northeast of Iceland. It is much smaller than Svalbard.

Are there polar bears in Svalbard & Jan Mayen?

The icy islands of Svalbard and Jan Mayen are a paradise for polar explorers. These frozen frontiers feature stark yet stunning scenery and the Arctic's most iconic wildlife, including polar bears. Deep within the Arctic Circle and surrounded by icy open ocean, Svalbard and Jan Mayen are some of the most remote outposts imaginable.

What to do in Svalbard?

Smeerenburg, or "blubber town", is an old whaling station dating back to the 17th century where many relics of the era can still be seen. When ice conditions allow, it is also possible to venture to Svalbard's easternmost island, Kvitøya, located within the Nordaust-Svalbard Nature Reserve.

Where is Svalbard located?

Svalbard is an archipelago in the Arctic about midway between mainland Norway and the North Pole. The group of islands range from 74° to 81° north latitude, and from 10° to 35° east longitude. The area is 61,022 square kilometres (23,561 sq mi) and there were 2,595 residents in Sept 2024.

Where to stay in Norway & Svalbard?

Then you get a couple of mid-range options -- we heard good things about Mary-Ann's Polarrigg. And if your budget allows, you can indulge with a stay at the Radisson or Funken Lodge. The selection of restaurants in Longyearbyen is surprisingly big! Norway is not cheap in general, but prices in Svalbard are not higher than on the continent.

What makes Jan Mayen so special?

Defined by the 2,277-metre tall Mt Beerenberg, this isolated island is renowned for its utterly abysmal weather, which can make landings difficult. But, should the skies clear and the sun shine, Jan Mayen's exquisite beauty comes into full focus - with the fleeting nature of these opportunities only adding to the mystique.
