The Current State of Energy Supply in Sierra Leone. Sierra Leone is currently wrestling with an energy poverty crisis, having one of the highest rates in the world. In 2022, 15% of people in Sierra Leone had access to electricity. In rural areas, electricity is almost completely scarce, with only 2.5% of the population having access.
