Technicians in Timor-Leste have experience in small-scale, off-grid solar energy systems. Commercial or industrial scale installations are more complex and appropriate technical capacity is scarce.

Will Indonesia & Timor-Leste be able to install solar panels?

Jakarta, 4 Nov. 2022 -- At least 80 technicians from Indonesia and Timor-Leste have completed training on Solar PV technology, by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) with support from the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) paving the way for more installation of solar panels in the remote parts of the countries.

How long does a solar system last in Timor-Leste?

High electricity costs and readily available solar radiation mean that the average payback period for a rooftop photovoltaic (PV) solar energy system in Timor-Leste is only 1.5 to 3 years instead of the global average of 6-10 years. Transitioning to solar can also help the country meet environmental commitments.

Why is Timor-Leste not able to finance solar panels?

MDF research found that lenders in Timor-Leste are unwilling to lend to small and medium sized enterprises due to levels of default, perceived risks, and the difficulty of securing collateral.
