Vatican Solar Path. Building solar plants is a part of the Vatican's historical plan to go green. In 1971 Pope Paul VI in 1971 said that 'humanity risked destroying nature by exploiting it'. However, the first materialistic steps were made only in 2008, when 2,400 solar panels were installed on the roofs of the Vatican's Paul V Hall.

Vatican City will soon be 100 percent solar-powered, becoming the eighth country to achieve this milestone.
