The majority of its population lives on the four main islands of Anegada, Jost ... Jost Van Dyke and seven other smaller islands. Anegada has its own power station that provides 24-hour service.

The islands were named "Santa Ursula y las Once Mil Virgenes" by Christopher Columbus in 1493 after the legend of Saint Ursula and the 11,000 virgins. [3] [5] The name was later shortened to "the Virgin Islands".[3]The official name of the territory is still simply the "Virgin Islands", but the prefix "British" is often used.
